## FACT SHEET

### Facebook – Commenting & Uploading Photos

*Once you have your Facebook account set up, you're ready to start interacting with your friends, and the pages you've liked.*

#### Commenting on a status:

1. For items which come up in your news feed, or items you're looking at on someone else's page, commenting is easy.
2. Beneath the status, you will see "Comment" (shown here)
3. Click on this, and you will see a box appear underneath, which says "Write a comment"
4. Type your comment directly into that box, then press Enter to submit your comment
5. If, after submitting, you realise you've made a mistake, or want to change your comment, hold the mouse over the pencil icon, found to the right of your comment. "Edit or Delete" will appear (shown here). Click on this, and choose either "Edit" or "Delete".



#### Uploading photos:

1. From your main Facebook page (if you're unsure where you are, clicking "Home" at the top, right-hand side of the page, will always take you to the main page), click "Add Photos/Video", then select "Upload Photos/Video"
2. Select the photo you want to upload.
3. Above the photo, where you see "Say something about this photo", type in a comment about the photo (as shown).
4. Click "Post"
