YouTube – Set up an Account

Launched in 2005, YouTube is a video-sharing website, on which users can upload, view and share videos. Unregistered users can watch videos, but if you wish to upload your own videos, or post comments on other videos, you will need to set up an account.

YouTube can be found at www.youtube.com

As YouTube is now owned by Google, if you have a Google account, you will be able to sign in to YouTube by entering your Google Account username and password. If you're already signed into your Google Account on a different Google service, you'll be automatically signed in when you visit YouTube as well. If you don't have a Google account, you will need to create one, in order to sign in to YouTube.

1. To create a Google account, follow this link:
<https://accounts.google.com/SignUp?service=youtube>
2. Choose a username and enter in your contact information
3. Click "Next Step".
4. The next step is setting up your profile. You can upload or take a photo (if you have a webcam on your computer). You can skip this step, and do it later, or not at all.
5. Click "Next Step".
6. The next screen shows you how your profile will appear.
7. Click "Next Step".
8. The next screen should tell you your account is created.
9. Your account is now set up. Head to www.youtube.com and sign in to start sharing videos!

What is a Google Account?

Google Accounts is a unified sign-in system that gives you access to Google products, including iGoogle, Gmail, Google Groups, Picasa, Web History, YouTube, and more.

If you've used any of these products before, you already have a Google Account.

Your account username is the email address you entered when you created your Google Account. If you use Gmail, sign in with your Gmail username.
