The Hart Winter Walk, from 9:00am-12:00pm, will involve an informal guided walk and inspection of the trial site post seeding. Guest speakers will outline 2022 trials.

The NGN Forum, from 12:30-2:30pm, will gather grass roots input into GRDC's investment plans by capturing opportunities and constraints facing local growers. You will also have the opportunity to talk to GRDC representatives and researchers working on GRDC investments. The forum will be led by GRDC Grower Relations Managers Randall Wilksch and Tom Blake, who will provide insights into current research and extension projects.

A facilitated workshop session will identify factors impacting farm productivity and profitability and review opportunities for local GRDC research, development and extension support.
